# **Decorating Guidelines and Requirements** (Must Read)

• Decorate your tree anytime between November 29th and December 2nd. Decorating hours will be between 10am and 5pm. If you would like to do it outside of those hours just let us know, we can meet up with you to plug in your tree and any other help you may need.

- Your assigned tree will be up and have a sponsor sign displayed beside it. Look for your name.
- The sponsor/decorator provides all lights and decorations.
- The live trees will be approximately 6 ft. in height.
- You can use 4 to 5 strings of LED lights per tree. Be sure to check your lights to make sure they are working before putting them on the tree.
- Do not use glass ornaments, or loose tinsel. (garland is fine)
- Please use decorations that can withstand the wind and rain. Laminate paper decorations.
- Bring a step stool or ladder so you can reach the top of your tree to decorate it.
- Consider that ornament hooks may not hold up in winds, other options to consider are small plastic zip ties, pipe cleaners, string, or other ties should be used to secure your decorations.
- While you are decorating, please watch small children as they can trip and fall on cords, wires. Also there are busy streets on either side and we want to ensure everyone's safety. Adults should exercise care, too!
- Trees should stay decorated from Friday, December 2nd to Thursday, December 29th
- Remember: Decorations and lights may be removed Thursday, December 29th. NOT BEFORE.
  - Any decorations and lights must be removed by Tuesday, January 3rd. Please do not leave any zip ties or decorations on the ground as they are hazardous to wildlife. Thank you
