

Russell Auditorium



The Lou and John Russell Auditorium is an intimate space that is perfect for small receptions or business meetings. Located adjacent to the Rassbach Museum lobby, the 32' x 23.5' room includes drop-down screen for presentations. This room can comfortably seat 45 for a speaker, up to 30 seated at tables, or 50 for standing reception (*fire capacity is 63*). Room to stage light food and drink is available.

Extras available for rent include tables, chairs, podium, and AV/sound equipment. We offer simple house sound and lighting and wireless internet. See our rental agreement for details. We might have something else you may need for your event too—just ask!

Parking is available with 35 spaces (“*as available*” basis during museum hours) is adjacent to the museum and additional parking is available on the street nearby.

If you wish to pair your rental with a **Rassbach Museum tour** or **Fulton’s Workshop activity**, an additional fee applies.

The Rassbach Museum welcomes any individual, business, agency or organization to rent meeting or event space at our location. We offer spaces perfect for birthday parties, reunions, anniversaries, weddings, memorials, corporate events and more. All areas are handicap accessible. Our spaces are priced to meet just about any size budget, whether you are having a small, intimate gathering or a larger affair. We offer discounted rates to business members of the Society and non-profits.

Holtby Hall Options

Holtby Hall offers two easily accessible and versatile spaces that include access to a prep kitchen. Holtby Hall can comfortably seat 150-200 for a speaker, up to 150 seated at tables (25 8' tables with six people each) or up to 400 for a standing reception (fire capacity is 532).

A full space rental includes the **Holtby Hall Alcove** which may be rented separately. A neutral color scheme and minimal fixtures allow the space to be transformed into a personalized venue for your event.

The **Prep Kitchen**, available at additional charge, offers ample space to prepare food and beverage, and includes use of coffee makers, microwave, refrigerator/freezer, and rolling carts.

Eastside Lawn

Take your event outside with our schoolyard setting on the east side of the museum. The historic Hilcrest School is a classic one-room school typical of those once found throughout Dunn County. Because of its historic value, events cannot be held inside the school, however, the lawn offers a unique setting for an outdoor wedding, reception, games or activities, or performance space. A tent can be erected on the grounds. Guests will have access to the restrooms in the Rassbach Museum building.
