Do you love eating pie? Do you think you can eat one faster than everyone else? Then register to be a part of the Pie Eating Contest at the Rassbach Museums Picnics and Petals May Day Celebration. May 1 at the Rassbach Museum lawn in Wakanda Park.

Categories: Children 6-9 2:00 pm Youth 10-15 2:30 pm Adults 16+ 3:45 pm	Entry Fee: \$5 for children and youth \$10 for Adults
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CONTEST RULES/ INFORMATION

- Registration is limited to five participants in each category.
- Awards will be given to 1st place in each category. Chamber Checks in the amount of:
Children: \$25 Youth: \$50 Adult: \$50
- Children will be given one piece of pie. Winner is the first to consume their pie, or most eaten in 5 minutes.
- Youth will be given one mini pie. Winner is first to consume their pie, or most eaten in 5 minutes.
- Adults will be given one whole pie. Winner is first to consume their pie, or most eaten in 10 minutes.
- The judge's decision is final.
- *Hands are not to be used to consume the pie.* Contestants may use their hands to drink water.
- Any visible signs of sickness/distress will cause disqualification.
- The first person to finish their pie will throw their hands in the air to end the contest and be judged the winner.
Judges will decide if pie is actually finished before ending the contest.
- Parent or guardian of participants younger than 18 must consent to participation and be present at time of contest.
- Pie will be vanilla pudding with whipped topping
